

How to Import Your PDF or ePub to Your Preferred Reader

Once you've downloaded your book, you can read it on almost any device. Below are step-by-step instructions for importing your **PDF** or **ePub** file into some of the most popular reading apps and devices.

1. Amazon Kindle

Supported format: Kindle doesn't natively read ePub (unless converted), but newer Kindles can handle ePub sent via the Send to Kindle feature. PDFs can be sent directly.

Method A – Send to Kindle

1. Install the **Send to Kindle** app on your computer or use the **Send to Kindle email address** for your device (find it in your Kindle settings under "Your Account" → "Send-to-Kindle Email").
2. Attach your **PDF** or **ePub** to an email and send it to that address.
3. Within minutes, the book will appear on your Kindle library.

Method B – USB Transfer

1. Connect your Kindle to your computer via USB.
 2. Drag and drop the PDF file into the **Documents** folder on your Kindle.
 3. Safely eject the device and open the book from your Kindle's home screen.

2. Apple Books (iPhone, iPad, Mac)

Supported format: ePub and PDF (both work perfectly).

On iPhone or iPad:

1. Open the PDF or ePub from your email or download location.
2. Tap the **Share** icon and select **Books**.
3. It will be saved to your Apple Books library automatically.

On Mac:

1. Open **Books** on your Mac.
 2. Drag the PDF or ePub into the Books window or choose **File → Add to Library**.
 3. The book will sync to your iPhone/iPad if you use iCloud.

3. Google Play Books

Supported format: ePub and PDF.

From a Computer:

1. Go to Google Play Books and log in.
2. Click **My Books → Upload Files**.
3. Choose your PDF or ePub and upload it.
4. It will sync to all devices with Google Play Books installed.

From an Android device:

1. Download the PDF or ePub to your phone/tablet.
 2. Open Google Play Books, tap **Library**, then **Import**.
 3. Select the file to add it to your collection.

4. Kobo eReader / Kobo App

Supported format: ePub (preferred) and PDF.

Using Kobo Desktop (easiest):

1. Download and install **Kobo Desktop** from Kobo's website.
2. Connect your Kobo via USB.
3. Drag your ePub or PDF into Kobo Desktop.
4. Sync your Kobo to transfer the file.

For the Kobo app on mobile:

- Simply open the ePub or PDF and choose **Open in Kobo** from the share menu.

5. Other Reading Apps

If you're using apps like **Calibre**, **PocketBook**, or **Moon+ Reader**, simply open the app and use its "Import" or "Add Book" function to select your PDF or ePub from your downloads folder.
